PROGRAM INFORMATION  
Grades 9 thru 12

THEME:  
“American History: Our Hope for the Future”

Eligibility: Ninth (9<sup>th</sup>), Tenth (10<sup>th</sup>), Eleventh (11<sup>th</sup>) and Twelfth (12<sup>th</sup>) grade students in public, private, parochial and home schools in the State of Michigan. Former first place winners at the State and National level competition or any foreign exchange student are not eligible. Students do not have to be a relative of a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars or its VFW Auxiliary to participate.

Submit your script and recording to the Chevrolet Motor Post 3087. Please include your contact information, along with a telephone number so we may contact you if you are selected. If selected, you will be required to submit the official entry forms. These forms must be completed to be considered for the final entry. Failure to submit these forms will result in disqualification. Foreign exchange students are not eligible.

Recording: Recorded scripts must not be less than THREE (3) minutes nor longer than FIVE (5) minutes. A five (5) second variation is acceptable to compensate for the possible deviation in equipment. Scripts MUST be recorded on full sized standard FLASH DRIVE OR CD ONLY. Record all on CD's or a Flash Drive on a single track, Scripts must be recorded without music of background voice. Students must not use their names, the name or location of the sponsoring VFW unit, or the name or location of their school. Recordings must not include any introduction of the script. The only voice on the recording must be that of the student's. Special consideration may be given for the students that are speech challenged upon the written request through. Scripts should be recorded using the best possible equipment available. A copy of the script must be submitted with recording.
